

Notice of Ordinance Adoption

To: The residents and property owners of the Township of Nunda, Cheboygan County, Michigan, and any other interested persons

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that at a regular meeting of Nunda Township held on October 11, 2022, the Township Board of Trustees of Nunda Township adopted Ordinance No. 2022-04.

The summary of this ordinance appears below:

TOWNSHIP OF NUNDA CEMETERY ORDINANCE ORDINANCE #2022-04

SECTION 1 - Title. This section gives the name of the ordinance and citation of the ordinance as the “**NUNDA TOWNSHIP CEMETERY ORDINANCE**”.

SECTION 2 - Purpose and Intent. This Section sets forth the purpose and intent of the ordinance.

SECTION 3 - Definitions. This Section gives definitions of the terms words and phrases used in the ordinance.

SECTION 4 - Sale of Cemetery Plots; Nontransferable. This Section explains terms of how burial spaces can be purchased are to be made, the forms to be used and the burial rights obtained.

SECTION 5 - Purchase Price. This Section explains how purchase prices of cemetery lots and burial spaces are set .

SECTION 6 - Grave Opening Charges. This Section explains how graves are to be opened and closed and the manner in which grave opening charges are determined.

SECTION 7 - Markers or Memorials; No Monuments. This Section explains the type of markers or memorials which may be used in a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 8 - Interment Regulations. This Section sets forth various regulations applicable to interment in a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 9 - Disinterments. This Section sets forth rules and regulations pertaining to disinterments in a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 10 - Winter Burials. This Section sets forth that winter burials are not allowed in a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 11 - Cremains. This Section sets forth rules and regulations pertaining to cremains.

SECTION 12 - Ground Maintenance. This Section sets forth rules and regulations pertaining to the maintenance of the grounds of a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 13 - Disclaimer of Township Liability and Responsibility. This Section disclaims any and all liability for injuries, accidents or calamities that occur to any person entering in or on the grounds of a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 14 - Forfeiture of Vacant Cemetery Lots or Burial Spaces. This Section sets forth rules and regulations pertaining to the forfeiture of vacant cemetery lots or burial spaces from the owners thereof.

SECTION 15 - Repurchase of Lots or Burial Spaces. This Section sets forth the conditions upon which lots may be repurchased from the owners thereof.

SECTION 16 - Records. This Section explains who shall be responsible for compiling and maintaining the records of a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 17 - Vault. This Section sets forth the requirement for a vault to be used in each burial space before interment.

SECTION 18 - Cemetery Hours. This Section sets forth the manner of establishing cemetery hours that the cemetery shall be open to the general public.

SECTION 19 - Prohibited Uses and Activities. This Section sets forth the uses and activities that are prohibited in a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 20 - Authority of Township Sexton. This Section sets forth the authority of the Township Sexton.

SECTION 21 - Fees. This Section sets forth that the Nunda Township Board of Trustees have the right to set fees for use of a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 22 - Applicability of this Ordinance. This Section sets forth the circumstances in which the Ordinance is applicable.

SECTION 23 - Interpretation/Appeals to the Township Board. This Section sets forth the authority that the Township Board of Trustees has in interpreting the Ordinance and in hearing appeals from decisions related to a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 24 - Authority of the Township to Remove Unauthorized or Unlawful Items from a Township Cemetery. This Section sets forth authority the township has to remove unauthorized or unlawful items from a Nunda Township Cemetery.

SECTION 25 - Penalties. This Section sets forth penalties for non-compliance with the ordinance and establishes fines a violation of the ordinance.

SECTION 26 - Township Officials Who Can Enforce this Ordinance. This Section sets forth the persons who may enforce the terms of the Ordinance.

SECTION 27 - Severability. This Section provides that if any portion of the ordinance are declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other portion of the ordinance.

SECTION 28 - Effective Date. This Section establishes that the ordinance shall take effect 30 days following their publication after adoption, and further, repeals all ordinances or parts of an ordinance which are in conflict with the ordinance.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE GENERAL ELECTION WILL BE HELD IN THE COUNTY OF CHEBOYGAN, STATE OF MICHIGAN, on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. The Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 P.M.

The purpose of the November General Election is to vote for the following offices and millage proposals:

Federal: United States Senator and Representative in Congress – 1st District. **State:** Governor, Lt. Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State Senator – 37th District, Representative in State Legislature – 106th & 107th District. **Judicial:** Justice of Supreme Court and Judge of Court of Appeals. **State Boards:** Member of the State Board of Education, Regent of the University of Michigan, Governor of Wayne State and Trustees of Michigan State University. **County:** 53rd Circuit Court Judge, County Road Commissioner and County Commissioner (Districts 1-7). **Township (Partial Terms):** Aloha Township; Clerk; Grant Township; Clerk – Inverness Township; Clerk – Mackinaw Township; Clerk - Tuscarora Township; Clerk – Inverness Township; Supervisor – Wilmot Township; Supervisor - Koehler Township; Treasurer - Nunda Township; Treasurer – Wilmot Township; Treasurer - Grant Township; Constable – Inverness Township; Trustee and Wilmot Township; Trustee. **City of Cheboygan:** Mayor and City Council Members. **School Board Members:** Cheboygan Area School, Mackinaw City Public School, Inland Lakes School, Onaway Public Schools, Pellston Public School, Vanderbilt Area Schools, Wolverine Community School and Char-EM ISD. **Village of:** Mackinaw City and Wolverine.

CHEBOYGAN AREA SCHOOL PROPOSAL: Operating Millage Proposal – be renewed by 18.1810 mills (\$18.1810 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period five (5) years, 2024-2028, inclusive, and also be increased by .05 mill (\$0.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of five (5) years 2024-2028, inclusive to provide funds for operating purposes.

VANDERBILT AREA SCHOOL PROPOSAL: Operating Millage Proposal – in Otsego, Charlevoix and Cheboygan Counties, Michigan, be increased by 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for the year 2023 and 19 mills (\$19.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2024 to 2028, inclusive to provide funds for operating purposes.
